AE and CE Level 3, Phase 2 AACUP survey visit

Two 5-year programs of College of Engineering and Information Technology were evaluated by Accrediting Agency of Chartered Colleges and Universities in the Philippines (AACUP). The accreditation survey visit was held on December 9, 2013 at the Lasap Hall, Administration Building. The programs that qualified for Level 3, Phase 2 surveys were Bachelor of Science in Agricultural Engineering (BSAE) and Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering (BSCE).

A simultaneous question and answer proceeded right after the presentations to clarify some concerns of the evaluators. The University president, Dr. Divinia C. Chavez, vice president for Academic Affairs, Dr. Ma. Agnes P. Nuestro, vice president for Administrative and Support Services, Dr. Hernando P. Robles, vice president for Research, Extension, and Continuing Education Trainings and Services (RECETS), Dr. Alejandro DC. Mojica Sr., deans, directors, faculty members, students, and extension project beneficiaries of the programs under survey attended the activity.

New BS Architecture Board Passers

The College of Engineering and Information Technology (CEIT) congratulates its four newly registered architects, namely: Marie Shen L. Batulan, Paolo Jose P. Llanes, Sherry Anne B. Ortega, and Yvonne B. Pavia. The Architect Licensure Examination was held on January 17 and 19, 2014 and the Philippine Regulation Commission (PRC) announced the result on January 23, 2014. CvSU got 66.67% (four out of six takers) which is higher than the national passing of 54.99 %.

CEIT Congratulates its 5 Newly Accredited English Critics

Dr. Leyma L. Cero, Prof. Renato B. Cubilla, Ms. Gemmae G. Pitong, Ms. Ria Clarisse L. Mojica, and Ms. Kate Cristel C. Mojica were among the faculty members who passed the accreditation for English critics. The examination was administered on January 17 and 24, 2014 by the University Accreditation Committee headed by its Chairman Prof. Adora Joy T. Plete. As per Board Resolution No. 17 series 2012, dated March 8, 2012, only the accredited English critics can edit manuscripts of students.

CEIT Introduces the First CvSU Faculty Association Online Voting System

January 30, 2014 marked a breakthrough in the Cavite State University (CvSU) Faculty Association (FA) as it accepted the challenge of technology by adopting the first CvSU-FA online voting system. In the past years, the association's elections were conducted manually.

Mr. Marlon R. Pereña, chairman of CvSU-FA election committee with the faculty members of the Department of Information Technology (DIT), launched the system as approved by the association. Activities involved the set-up of the voting precinct, with 10 computer systems at the College of Education Audio Visual Room for all the members in the main campus and for the members from the 10 branch campuses simultaneously via the University's official website, www.cvsu.edu.ph. Nearly 80 percent members of the FA participated in the election. Among them were Drs. Divinia Chavez, University president, Ma. Agnes Nuestro, vice president of Academic Affairs, and Luzviminda Rodrin, vice president of External and Business Affairs and Human Resource Management Office director, Mary Jane D. Tepora. The Online Voting System used in the election is an on-going thesis of the Bachelor of Science in Information Technology (BSIT) graduating students namely: Yohjin S. Bermejo and Maridel D. Dimatulac with Ms. Gladys G. Perey as their adviser.
