Cavite State University, through its Bids and Award Committee (BAC), invites all interested suppliers/manufacturers/distributors/contractors, who are technically, legally and financially capable, to submit proposals for the following project;

Procedures for Negotiated Procurement for Second Failure of Bidding (Sec. 53.1) of the revised IRR of RA 9184 will be adopted for the above-mentioned project.

The procurement is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnership, or organizations with at least seventy five percent (75%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizen of the Philippines.

Negotiation shall only be made to the bidder who submitted the lowest calculated bid (LCB). If the offer of the LCB is not responsive to the original specifications and ABC, negotiation shall be made in ascending order starting from the lowest offer. The bidder whose bid is found to be responsive to the original specifications and ABC shall be considered for award.

A complete list of technical and financial proposal requirements maybe secured by the authorized representative of the interested supplier from the BAC Secretariat starting August 7, 2018.

Bid documents shall be issued to interested bidders upon payment of non-refundable fee amounting to Five Thousand Pesos only (\$\mathbb{P}\$ 5,000,00) to the CAVITE STATE UNIVERSITY Cashier.

Technical and financial proposals must be delivered personally to the BAC Secretariat, CvSU, Indang, Cavite on or before August 23, 2018 (1:00 pm).

Cavite State University assumes no responsibility whatsoever to compensate or indemnify bidders for any expenses incurred in the preparation of the bid.

Cavite State University reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process, and to reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
