

Cavite State University (CvSU), through the National Coffee Research, Development and Extension Center (NCRDEC) will be hosting the second National Coffee Education Congress with the theme Unifying Industry Initiatives Toward Sustainability of Philippine Coffee" on December 3 to 5, 2019 at CvSU, Indang, Cavite.

The Congress primarily aims to converge research and extension initiatives of all the coffee stakeholders which are contributory to the development of the Philippine coffee industry.

REGISTRATION:

The registration fee is PhP 4,500.00 per participant inclusive of congress kit, meals (am snacks, lunch and pm snacks) and coffee tour for the whole duration of the congress.

RESEARCH AND EXTENSION PAPER AND POSTER PRESENTATIONS

All researchers and other stakeholders from higher education institutions (HEIs), both public and private colleges and universities and other government or private research institutions working on research, development, and extension works on coffee are invited to submit their original technical papers for oral and poster presentations.

The research/extension activity should have been conducted in the last 5 years. Abstract not exceeding 300 words, containing the short background, objectives, methodology, major findings and conclusions, should be submitted at ncec2papers@gmail.com on or before November 8, 2019 (Friday, 11:59 pm).

Authors of qualified abstracts will be notified thru email on November 12 (Tuesday). Guidelines in writing the extended abstract and format of poster paper will be forwarded to the authors together with the acceptance letter.

Winning papers and poster will receive a certificate and cash prize of:

Best Paper: Php 20,000
2nd Place: Php 15,000
3rd Place: Php 10,000

Best Poster: Php 5,000.00

COFFEE CUPPING COMPETITION

Calling all coffee processors and coffee shop owners! Have your signature coffee blend be cupped by certified coffee cuppers and be the very first winner of NCEC 2.0 National Coffee Cupping Competition. Each coffee owner may submit maximum of 3 samples for a fee of PhP 1,000.00 per sample.

Winners will receive a plaque and cash prize of:

1st Place: PhP 10,000 (2) Honorable Mentions: PhP 5,000

BARISTA COMPETITION

The Barista Competition is open to all tertiary students from universities and colleges in the country with barista skills. The competition will focus on promoting the excellence in different coffee concoctions.

Competitors will be judged according to cleanliness, creativity, flavour, technical skill and overall presentation.

Winners will receive a certificate and cash prize of:

1st Place: PhP 10,000 2nd Place: PhP 7,000 3rd Place: PhP 5,000



All tertiary students from Universities and Colleges in the country are invited to submit a documentary film entry in line with the theme, "Unifying Industry Initiatives toward Sustainability of Philippine coffee". A minimum registration fee of PhP 1,000.00 will be charged per entry.

Documentary film entries must be minimum of ten (10) minutes and maximum of twenty (20) minutes long (including opening title and closing credits). It can be shot and edited using any video recording device (i.e. smartphones, digital cameras, high-definition cameras, etc.) and any video editing software/s.

The documentary film entries will be evaluated based on Content and Clarity of the Message (35%), Originality and Creativity of Approach (30%), Coherence to the Theme (25%) and Video and Audio Quality (10%).

Special awards such as Best in Cinematography and People's Choice will be given plaque.

Three winners for the Best Documentary Category will receive a plaque and cash prize which amounts to:

Best Coffee Documentary: PhP 15,000 2nd Place: PhP 10,000 3rd Place: PhP 5,000



This year, we will recognize outstanding coffee cooperatives in the country that contributes to the promotion and development of our local coffee industry. This will highlight the cooperative's best practices and their exceptional coffee produce.

Winners will receive a plaque and cash prize amounting to:

Outstanding Coffee Cooperative: PhP 10,000 Honorable Mention: PhP 5.000


