1. INSTITUTIONAL PLANNING

a. YEAR-END REVIEW AND STRATEGIC PLANNING

The Office of the Vice President for Planning and Development (OVPPD) facilitated the University's Year-End Review on 4 February via CISCO Webex. The meeting focused on six areas: (1) COPC, Accreditation, COD and COE, (2) Infrastructure Development, (3) SMART University, (4) Research University, (5) Edu-Tourism, and (6) PRIME-HRM.









b. PRESENTATION OF CONSOLIDATED STRATEGIC PLAN AND OPERATIONAL PLANNING FOR FY 2021

On 22 February, the members of the Administrative Council convened virtually for the continuation of the strategic planning activity. The vice presidents presented the consolidated strategic plans of their units.





c. SETTING OF UNIVERSITY TARGETS FOR FY 2022

The vice presidents held an online meeting on 2 June to finalize the University Targets on the Major Final Outputs for FY 2022.



d. ONLINE ORIENTATION ON THE GUIDELINES FOR FY 2021 PBB

An online orientation regarding the guidelines for FY 2021 PBB was also facilitated by OVPPD on 10 August.





e. PRELIMINARY WORKSHOP IN PREPARATION TO THE UNIVERSITY STRATEGIC PLANNING ACTIVITY

On 9-10 November, the members of the Administrative Council were divided into four clusters: campus administrators, college deans, directors and other academic heads, and R&E and center directors; for a preliminary workshop prior to the strategic planning activity of the University for FY 2022.





























f. SETTING OF QUARTERLY TARGETS FOR FY 2022

On 16 November, vice presidents and heads of offices concerned met virtually to deliberate and decide on the University's quarterly targets for FY 2022.



g. YEAR-END REVIEW AND STRATEGIC PLANNING FOR 2022

On 6-7 December, unit heads presented their accomplishment reports for FY 2021 in terms of Major Final Outputs. The draft operational plan for FY 2022 was also presented to the council members for comments and suggestions.

















h. PRESENTATION OF SWOT ANALYSIS AND REVIEW OF UNIVERSITY'S STRATEGIC PLAN 2021-2024

The results of the SWOT analysis was presented to the members of the Administrative Council on 20 December. The strategic plan for 2021-2024 was also reviewed. Comments and additional inputs were considered in the updated plan.



2. PERFORMANCE MANAGEMENT

a. PERFORMANCE MANAGEMENT TEAM (PMT) MEETINGS

The team met four times (16 February, 8 July, 26 October, and 4 November) and deliberated on the ranking of delivery units, revisions of the SPMS Manual, evaluation of the reorientation webinar, update/status of PBB, and calibration of targets, among others.









b. REORIENTATION WEBINAR ON THE REVISED SPMS MANUAL

A 5-day reorientation webinar was conducted on 15, 17, 23, and 25 June, and 01 July, to discuss the revisions on the university's SPMS Manual. The resource speakers during the webinar were the members of the PMT, while the attendees were the members of the Administrative Council.


a. UNIVERSITY INFORMATION SYSTEMS

Updated the Online Grade Uploading System


The grade portal now uses the Google Single-Sign On (SSO) and requires the official CvSU e-mail for log-in.




The list of all subjects offered for the active school year and semester are now available.



The list of available subjects can be filtered by schedule code, course, and subject title.




Setting of grades will assign the subject to the instructor/professor.




• Developed the Online Pre-Registration Portal


The online pre-registration portal can be accessed by registered faculty members using their CvSU e-mail accounts.




The system allows the adviser to create a list of advisees to monitor the record.




The adviser can add new advisee by searching the name or student number of the student.







The list of advisees can be filtered to have a custom view of advisees based on certain criteria.




The list can also be organized via groups based on the preference of the adviser.




The adviser can create new groups and edit or remove existing groups.







The adviser can view the student's basic information.



The adviser can also view the grades of a student.




The system currently allows the adviser to register regular students.



Update on the Online Student Admission System (OSAS)




• CvSU Virtual Accreditation Center

The virtual room was also used for BS Tourism Management in August 2021.




Server Management and Monitoring

b. Training Course on Auditing QMS

To develop additional QMS Auditors to facilitate the conduct of internal quality audit in the University, a total of fourteen (14) individuals attended the Trainina Course on Auditing QMS from 3 to 14 May.

The training was done virtually and consists of lecture discussions and workshops.



c. Reorientation Webinar on Auditing QMS

An orientation on the ISO 9001:2015 Standards, CvSU Quality Management System, and selected quality procedures was provided to the QMS Auditors on 5 to 6 July. This activity also aimed to refamiliarize guide the auditors conducting the internal quality audit.



d. Internal Quality Audit

An internal quality audit was performed within the different offices of the University from 26 – 28 July and was extended until 09 August. QMS auditors reviewed the procedures being implemented by their assigned gudit areas and verified the presence of corresponding evidences, most audits were done

on-site while others were performed virtually. After thorough deliberation, 7 non-conformities (NCs) were found. Correction and corrective action reports (CCARs) were later then issued to the offices with identified NCs.



e. Management Review



f. Recertification Audit

Eight auditors from SOCOTEC Certification Philippines, Inc., conducted a rerecertification audit on 2 September. The activity aimed to confirm the continued conformity and effectiveness of the management system as a whole, and its continued relevance and applicability for the scope of certification. The assessment resulted to the recommendation for recertification of the University's QMS.



5. 5S GOOD HOUSEKEEPING

a. Re-orientation on Workplace Standards, Waste Management & Records Disposition

To regain awareness and solicit support from University personnel, a reorientation seminar on workplace standards was conducted on 9 March. This retooling session served as a channel to ensure the readiness of the University for the 5S Audit.
