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I. INSTITUTIONAL PLANNING

A. SETTING OF UNIVERSITY TARGETS FOR FY 2023

The vice presidents and heads of offices concerned convened on 11 April at the Board Room to finalize the University Targets on the Major Final Outputs for FY 2023.





B. REVIEW OF UNIVERSITY STRATEGIC PLANS

The Office of the Vice President for Planning and Development (OVPPD) facilitated the review of the University's strategic plans for 2016 – 2022 and 2021 – 2024 on 14 September and 3 October, respectively. The evaluation was attended by the vice presidents and selected university officials. The activity aimed to assess the accomplishments and performance of the institution throughout the years, and consider them as inputs for future planning undertakings.













C. STRATEGIC PLANNING FOR 2023 – 2028 & OPERATIONAL PLANNING FOR FY 2023

1. Assessment of Strategic Plan for 2016 – 2022

Members of the Administrative Council convened at the International Convention Center on 21 November for the annual strategic planning activity. Engr. Orlando B. Delos Reyes, Director for Planning, presented the summary of the review and assessment of the University's strategic plan for 2016 – 2022.





2. Presentation of Proposed Strategic Plan for 2023 – 2028

Dr. Adolfo C. Manuel, Jr., Director of the Institutional Development Office, discussed the proposed university strategic plan for 2023 – 2028. The proposed framework and plan were formulated considering the inputs from the conducted assessment of the strategic plan for 2016 – 2022, and instruments for SUC leveling and QS stars rating. It was during this session that the new tagline of the University was presented: **SHINE CVSU** which stands for **S**ustaining **H**olistic Innovations that **N**urtures **E**xcellence in CvSU. Comments and suggestions shared by the university officials were regarded as inputs for the improvement of the proposal.





3. Presentation of Operational Plan of Units





On 21, 28, 29 November and 14 December, the deans and directors presented their operational plans for FY 2023. Various recommendations were handed out by the members of the council for the enhancement of the plans.







On 14 December, President Hernando Robles presented the proposed vision of the University for 2023 – 2040.

II. PERFORMANCE MANAGEMENT

The Performance Management Team (PMT) met eight times (7, 21, and 24 March, 17 May, 3 August, 12 and 26 October, and 3 November) and discussed the calibration of OPCRs, update/status of PBB, determination of risks and opportunities re management processes, guidelines on the grant of CNA, and strategic planning schedule and proposal, among others.













III. MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM

A. BENCHMARKING AT TARLAC AGRICULTURAL UNIVERSITY

The Cavite State University iLAB Team, along with the SMART Campus Team, conducted a benchmarking visit to Tarlac Agricultural University (TAU) on 28 March. The Main Campus will establish its iLAB as an Innovation Laboratory for Global Education and Digital Citizenship through CHED.





B. INTEGRATED LIBRARY SYSTEM BENCHMARKING OF UNIVERSITY OF RIZAL SYSTEM

The library personnel from the University of Rizal System (URS) visited the Main Campus on 23 June for a benchmarking activity on the best practices of CvSU Library. Prof. James Angelo V. Aves from the MIS Unit shared the development of the university's online library system, control center, and information system.





C. WORKSHOP ON THE MANAGEMENT AND UTILIZATION OF THE ENROLLMENT SYSTEM

Together with the Office of the University Registrar, the MIS Unit conducted a 3-day workshop – 22, 23 and 25 August – on the management and utilization of the university enrollment system. Prof. Russel L. Villacarlos demonstrated the installation,






configuration, usage, and debugging of the server and system. The workshop was attended by the MIS staff, IT staff, and registrars from the branch campuses.

Implementation of features under the advising system such as campus management, course/program management, subject management, curriculum management, and fee management.




2. Updates on the CvSU Integrated Library System

Various improvements were made on the ILS such as the library system landing page, report summary on the dashboard, and Koha update from










• Content Summary of CvSU Integrated Library System

C. QMS BENCHMARKING OF PALAWAN STATE UNIVERSITY

Internal quality auditors from Palawan State University (PSU) visited the Main Campus for a benchmarking activity on best practices of ISO 9001:2015 implementation of the University on June 15. Aside from discussing technical strategies of the QMS team, the team also shared experiences and best practices in dealing with the challenges on technology usage, academic honesty of students, learning management system and plagiarism checker software used by the University, strategies for administering online examination, and data privacy.









D. INTERNAL QUALITY AUDIT

An internal quality audit was performed within the different offices of the University from 4-21 July and was extended until 8 August. QMS auditors reviewed the procedures being implemented by their assigned audit areas and verified the presence of corresponding evidences. After thorough deliberation, 1,057 conformities (Cs), 174 opportunities for improvement (OFIs), and 5 nonconformities (NCs) were found. Correction and corrective action reports (CCARs) were later then issued to the offices with identified NCs.

























E. MANAGEMENT REVIEW

During the midyear management review on 11 August, the Administrative Council and the QMS Core Team reviewed the performance of various services, satisfaction of stakeholders, and assessed opportunities for the continual improvement of the University's Quality Management System.













F. QMS CORE TEAM MEETINGS

The QMS Core Team met on 27 July to review the changes in external and internal issues that are relevant to the University, effectiveness of actions taken to address risks and opportunities, and other opportunities for improvement. On 10 August, the team also convened to discuss the preparations for the onsite surveillance audit.





G. FIRST SURVEILLANCE AUDIT

On 5 September 2022, the University's quality management system was subjected to an onsite surveillance audit by its partner auditing firm, SOCOTEC Certification Philippines, Inc. The audit team verified the compliance to standards of the university's processes on the areas of management of learning, research and extension, health services, security services, human resources, financial management services, external and business affairs, procurement, guidance, library, control of documented information, internal quality audit, and management review. The audit team was composed of Ms. Merian Domingo as the lead auditor, and Ms. Mercedelin Flores, Ms. Anna Manlangit, and Mr. Mark llagan as support auditors.




VIII. PROGRAM RECOGNITION




