Internationalization initiatives video bags 3rd best in CALABARZON

Highlighting the internationalization initiatives of the College of Arts and Sciences (CAS) in language education, Cavite State University won third Best Higher Education Institution (HEI) as Commission on Higher Education Region IVA celebrates 2021 ASEAN Month this August.

Anchored on the theme "We Care. We Prepare. We *Prosper*", CvSU's video entry focused on creating impact to the global community through language and multicultural programs offered by the Language Study Center under CAS. These include: 1) Intensive English Proficiency Course with 50 Taiwanese students from National Penghu University in 2019; 2) SWAP SHOP 2019 that capacitate foreign language teachers in various research-based and gender-sensitive methodologies; 3) SWAP SHOP 2021, a webinar series with international speakers sharing insights and tips in facilitating virtual classes; and 4) online Filipino101 Class for foreigners that catered to international students from CvSU, India and some Fulbright scholars. CvSU students, taking part as language buddies of some students from the University of Michigan and presenters in the Filipino language table of the Southeast Asian Club at Northern Illinois University, also became part of the presentation in some collaborations through scholarships, research, and internships abroad.

CvSU QCP celebration kicks off

To kick off the University's participation in the Quincentennial Commemoration in the Philippines, a program was virtually held on 25 August with Dr. Emmanuel Calairo, President of Cavite Historical Society and Commission of National Historical Commission of the Philippines as special guest.

After the opening program, a webinar on "Unang Misa sa Pilipinas" and "Birhen ng Candelaria" was

conducted with historian and Baliwag Polytechnic College President Atty. Robert John I. Donesa and Silang Vice Mayor Hon. Aidel Paul G. Belamide as speakers, respectively.

CvSU partners with Benetech/ BookShare

To address the needs of students and other clients with print disabilities, Cavite State University, through the initiative of the Gender and Development Resource Center, partnered with Benetech to set up a BookShare Corner in the University Library. This is the first-ever BookShare Corner set up in a university library in the Philippines and a pioneer BookShare Corner in CALABARZON.

Benetech is a US-based non-profit organization supporting people with disabilities through BookShare ebook library that makes reading easier for people with dyslexia, blindness, cerebral palsy, and other reading barriers.

During its virtual launching on 19 August, CvSU President Dr. Hernando D. Robles, in his message delivered by VP for Academic Affairs Dr. Ma. Agnes P. Nuestro, acknowledged the greater disadvantage faced by the visually impaired when it comes to content and information. He also expressed his gratitude to Benetech for choosing CvSU as one of its beneficiaries for the eLibrary that will cater to the reading needs of people who are blind or have other disabilities that affect reading.

Terra Verde Ecofarm partners with CvSU

The University recently signed a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with Terra Verde Ecofarm Inc. (TVEI) to further strengthen the University's extension and advisory services.

Through this agreement, the College of Agriculture, Food, Environment and Natural Resources (CAFENR) will extend technical assistance and other services to TVEI. As an initial activity, For. Junser P. Magpantay will assist TVEI in identifying the scientific name, common name and uses of the flora and fauna present in the farm. This will enable TVEI to promote to the general public the conservation and proper utilization of these flora and fauna.

The parties who signed the MOA include Dr. Hernando D. Robles, TVEI President Mr. Ericson B. Atanacio represented by Engr. Emerson Atanacio and Dr. Naomi Atanacio, CAFENR Dean Dr. Analita dM. Magsino, and Forester Junser P. Magpantay. The partnership was made possible through the assistance of Ms. Lorna C. Matel, Head of the Community Engagement and External Relations of Extension Services.
