CHED-CvSU Wide Area Network project: unlocking possibilities

With the sudden shift from the usual face-to-face operations, Cavite State University, just like all the other HEIs in the country, had to rapidly shift to virtual and digital strategies and adopted the CHED policy on flexible learning. Hence, CvSU submitted and presented a project proposal on Smart Campus Development to CHED Chairperson, commissioners, and technical panelists on 07 June 2021.

The proposal, with a total cost of P24,987,464.25 includes the establishment of the CvSU Wide Area Network (WAN) which aims to interconnect the local area networks (LANs) of the different campuses to the LAN of the main campus through the use of Software Driven WAN (SDWAN) technology. The interconnection will support sharing of resources among campuses, facilitate easy

deployment of in-house developed systems, and will serve as an initial step towards the implementation of the University Central Data Repository. Anent to this is the upgrading of the current internet subscription of the different campuses.

With the establishment and implementation of the CvSU WAN, the University's e-Learning System will likewise be upgraded. The improvements on the system include the integration of programming simulators, the tools for mathematical equations and computations, the link for web conferencing applications, and the inclusion of attendance module – enhancements that are expected to facilitate the easy conduct of flexible learning among the students and faculty members.
